

My son, Dylan, is an eighth grader at Commack Middle School. He was diagnosed with Osteosarcoma, a form of bone cancer, in August 2013, a few weeks before his

thirteenth birthday. He is being treated at Cohens Children's Medical Center.

Dylan has had many chemotherapy treatments and will complete his final round of chemo within the next month. Dylan had surgery in December 2013 to remove the bone tumor that was located in his right upper tibia, as well as to reconstruct his leg. He will have one more final reconstructive surgery this summer to replace his knee.

Despite more than 100 days in the hospital this past school year, Dylan has remained positive and always manages to make us smile. His eleven year old sister Shannon is his biggest supporter. Dylan's courage and bravery is an inspiration to all of us. He has the love and support of family and many friends, who have also been inspired by his spirit and determination.

Dylan enjoys fishing, boating, camping, swimming and sports. Like most teens he looks forward to spending time with his friends, and (believe it or not), getting to go to school when he is able to. Dylan looks forward to beginning high school this Fall.

During this difficult time we have been fortunate to have had support through the Michelle O'Neill Foundation. Michelle will always be remembered because of her warm, beautiful spirit and personality. Michelle continues to smile down on us through her foundation and we thank all of you for your support!

Allie was born with a rare abnormality that affected her whole digestive system and liver. She has had three extensive surgeries and

transfusions and was treated at Boston Children's Hospital in order to be seen by specialists.

Allie is at home now; she needs separation rooms for her IV care, which needs to be sterile. Allie's mom, Nanci, said "It's overwhelming to be without a doctor 24/7 but I'm learning to care for Allie and I have nurses 16 hours a day. She remains on IV pumps 16 hours a day and has a feeding tube. Her disease is called short gut as she does not have enough intestine to absorb nutrients from food. She is recovering from liver disease called TPN induced cholostatis. Allie has been a little fighter and with your help we can get her the best care possible."

In May 2013, when William was 4 years old, he was diagnosed with bi-lateral Wilms Tumors. He received weekly chemo

treatments, lung and abdominal radiation at Memorial Sloan Kettering until late July when he underwent surgery to remove his right kidney and the tumor in his left kidney. He returns to MSKCC once every three months for chemo and a checkup. Throughout his treatment he was a source of strength and inspiration to his Mom, Dad and twin brother, Clifford.

Once he received the green light from his doctors, he was able to start Pre K in late November. The best part according to William was riding the big school bus! He started swim lessons in the winter and joined the T Ball league in the spring and has a lot of love for both sports. We look forward to teaching him volleyball so one day he can proudly participate in the Michelle O'Neill Tournament to try to reciprocate some of the love and support he and his family received from this wonderful organization!
